This Scholarship Bulletin is a publication of the High Point Regional High School Guidance Department. Its purpose is to assist students and their parents with the financial aid process as they plan education beyond high school.

Deadlines are of the utmost importance throughout the scholarship process. Students who wait until the last minute to complete scholarship applications often miss out on aid for which they might otherwise have been eligible. *All Scholarship applications* are available in the Guidance office!

When filling out an application be concise and thorough. Mention all co-curricular activities, jobs, and volunteer positions. The information below is just a synopsis; other criteria may apply.

Branchville Rotary Scholarship

Three scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded to High Point students who are furthering their career at a 2 or 4 year college, technical or specialized school. An essay, describing how their observation of the Rotary motto "Service Above Self" has influenced the student's life and how observation of that motto has affected the student's community.

Grade: 12th

George J. Jackson Memorial Scholarship

Offered to high school seniors beginning their college studies this Fall. Several scholarships are awarded on merit and need. Prizes range between \$500-4,000. Must be Sussex County resident, prove financial need and demonstrate character, citizenship and scholarship. Full application available in guidance.

Sussex Rural Electric/Pennsylvania Rural Electric William Matson Scholarship

Available to seniors. SAT scores and financial need information required. If Sussex Rural Electric is your electric provider then you are eligible. Applications can be picked up in guidance.

Mid NJ Youth Soccer Liesel Krehan Memorial Scholarship

Two awards available. One to a female and one to a male who has participated or have been associated with a MNJYSA club or team as an athlete, volunteer or referee during their high school years. Applications can be found in guidance.

Available to students pursuing a career in a golf-related field.
